2024 RAKER - ROBERTA'S TRIAL GARDENS

The 2024 Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens are an opportunity to showcase your new and upcoming varieties to an ever-increasing number of industry experts and decision-makers.

The Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens – located in the middle of everywhere – are our primary means to conduct row, hanging basket, and large container plant trials. Last year, the Gardens displayed in excess of 3,200 unique varieties and attracted more than 1,400 horticulture professionals from around the world. In addition to onsite attendance, our trial website – <http://trialgardens.raker.com> – routinely has 5,000+ visitors each year.

Open from July 17 - September 1, the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens' season starts immediately after Cultivate'24 and continues throughout the summer.

Each Monday through Friday, Raker-Roberta's provides refreshments, restroom facilities, and a covered meeting area (w / wifi network) capable of hosting 200+ people. Contact us to discuss the

Summer 2024 marks the twenty-first year Raker-Roberta's will participate in the Michigan Garden Plant Tour. The Tour is a two-week event (July 29 – August 9) that delivers well over 1,000 horticulture professionals to the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens.

This 2024 Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens Prospectus outlines sponsorship opportunities available for your company to demonstrate your products' features and benefits.

In the hort industry, a typical tradeshow cost per lead is \$150 – invest \$150 to attain 1 lead, \$450 to attain 3 leads, etc.

A \$100 investment at the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens provides your product at least 2,000 views during the season.

Sponsorship opportunities are available on a "first come, first serve" basis. Raker-Roberta's will make every effort to accommodate interested sponsors, but space is limited. Based on previous years, it is advisable to reserve your space as soon as possible.

Since 2009, over 25,000 horticulturists have visited the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens – Even with the pandemic in 2021, more than 1,300 individuals visited the gardens!

Each year, the aim of Raker-Roberta's is to bring these individuals together for our big summer event: The 2024 Connection.

The Connection became popular as both starting and ending points for the Michigan Garden Plant Tour.

Our team will assist you with all aspects of your Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens' Event. Assisting with catered meals, suggesting overnight accommodations, catering meals, and providing dedicated meeting areas, especially for your event are examples of value-added services our team will provide.

SPONSOR ROWS

A primary focus of the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens, Sponsor Rows are located in the 10 beds immediately west and south of the primary meeting area. A perfect opportunity to display your genetics in a true, side-by-side evaluation.

There are 300 Sponsor Rows available, each measuring 15 feet. You may sponsor individual rows or entire beds (30 rows/bed).

Raker-Roberta's evaluates and photographs Sponsor Row content as part of our weekly data collection initiative. This information is immediately displayed on the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens' website (<http://trialgardens.raker.com>).

We use a 1-5 scale for the performance of the plants.

1=poor, 2=below average, 3=average, 4=good, 5=excellent

Points we take into consideration when scoring are, how are the plants holding up to the weather? Do they look healthy in regard to nutrition/disease pressure? How does the variety look compared to others? For the stand alone entries that don't have anything to compare them to the rating is based solely among that entry's performance. For something like Petunias the rating is based on how it is performing with the other submissions of petunias.

You supply the inputs (seed, unrooted or rooted cutting, etc.) and applicable care information. Our team provides propagation, planting, and maintenance throughout the trial season.

Each Sponsor Row is labeled with your company name and the plant's genus, species, and cultivar on a large, waterproof label. If applicable, the originator information is included.

Sponsor Rows may be located in either full sun or shade and are planted in raised rows covered with black plastic and mulch. Sponsor Rows receive water / nutrients regularly via in-ground irrigation tape.

LARGE CONTAINERS

Strategically located at the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens' entrance, the Large Container Gallery is an impressive space to feature your new genetics. Currently, we offer 265 large containers available to exhibit these varieties.

This immense area is quickly gaining distinction as the Midwestern alternative to the California Pack Trials. The 20-inch containers are arranged on a series of tiers, displaying your genetics prominently.

Raker-Roberta's evaluates and photographs Large Container content as part of our weekly data collection initiative. This information is immediately displayed on the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens' website (<http://trialgardens.raker.com>).

You supply the inputs (seed, unrooted or rooted cutting, etc.) and applicable care information. Our team provides propagation, planting, and maintenance throughout the trial season.

Each Large Container is labeled with your company name and the plant's genus, species, and cultivar on a large, waterproof label. If applicable, the originator information is included.

This Large Container Gallery offers 265 containers located in full sun and up to 90 containers located in shade. Each container receives water / nutrients via irrigation drip tube.

HANGING BASKETS

Also positioned at the entrance to the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens, the Hanging Basket displays are hot spots for horticulture visitors.

This area is a splendid showcase to feature plantings of new, trailing plant genetics. The 14-inch Hanging Baskets are positioned approximately 60 inches from the ground and allow trailing plants to achieve their full genetic potential.

You supply the inputs (seed, unrooted or rooted cutting, etc.) and applicable care information. Our team provides propagation, planting, and maintenance throughout the trial season.

Raker-Roberta's evaluates and photographs Hanging Basket content as part of our weekly data collection initiative. This information is immediately displayed on the

SPONSOR BEDS

Located on the perimeter of the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens, Sponsor Beds offer the the best opportunity to showcase plant product in a wide variety of displays. There are 12 Sponsor Beds available. Each is elevated about 2' and measures approximately 25' x 30' (750 ft² of growing space).

Design is your choice. Our team will work closely with you to make your vision become a reality - designs have included florascapes, row trials, or sets of large containers (limit 20 per bed). Sponsors may either submit a design or work with our landscape designer to create one based on your plant list. Please use the current "Sponsor Bed Layout" form included with this Prospectus to submit your design.

Raker-Roberta's will photograph Sponsor Bed content throughout the summer. In addition to the design, you supply the inputs (seed, unrooted or rooted cutting, etc.), applicable care information, and concept explanation.

Hardscape and accent items are welcome, but Raker-Roberta's reserves the right to use or not use these items. Our team provides propagation, planting, and maintenance throughout the trial season.

Plants within each Sponsor Bed are labeled with your company name and the plant's genus, species, and cultivar on a large, waterproof label. If applicable, the originator information is included.

Sponsor Beds are located in full sun and receive water / nutrients regularly via above ground sprinklers or hand irrigation.

HARD GOODS

In addition to plant-related sponsors, the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens is continuously seeking additional contributors for various materials.

For example, the RRTG uses 265+ pots for the Large Container Trials. Over the past few years, these 20-inch containers have been clay, plastic, and fiber. In addition to large containers, we use over 400 hanging baskets each year. Let us know your ideas!

Over the years, we have added fountains, sculptures, and garden structures to various areas of the Gardens. The Hydration Station is an area donated by Rough Brothers, Inc. that is a popular destination within the

Gardens and has stood the test of time.

In addition to garden-related items, the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens constantly needs office and outdoor event gear.

Office gear could include pens, pencils, notebooks, folders, or additional items usually distributed at trade shows.

Outdoor event gear may include hats, sun visors, umbrellas, sun lotion, or any items relating to sun shade or cover.

The minimum for office or outdoor event gear is 100 items. The maximum is up to you.

Please keep in mind the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens is seeking quality materials.

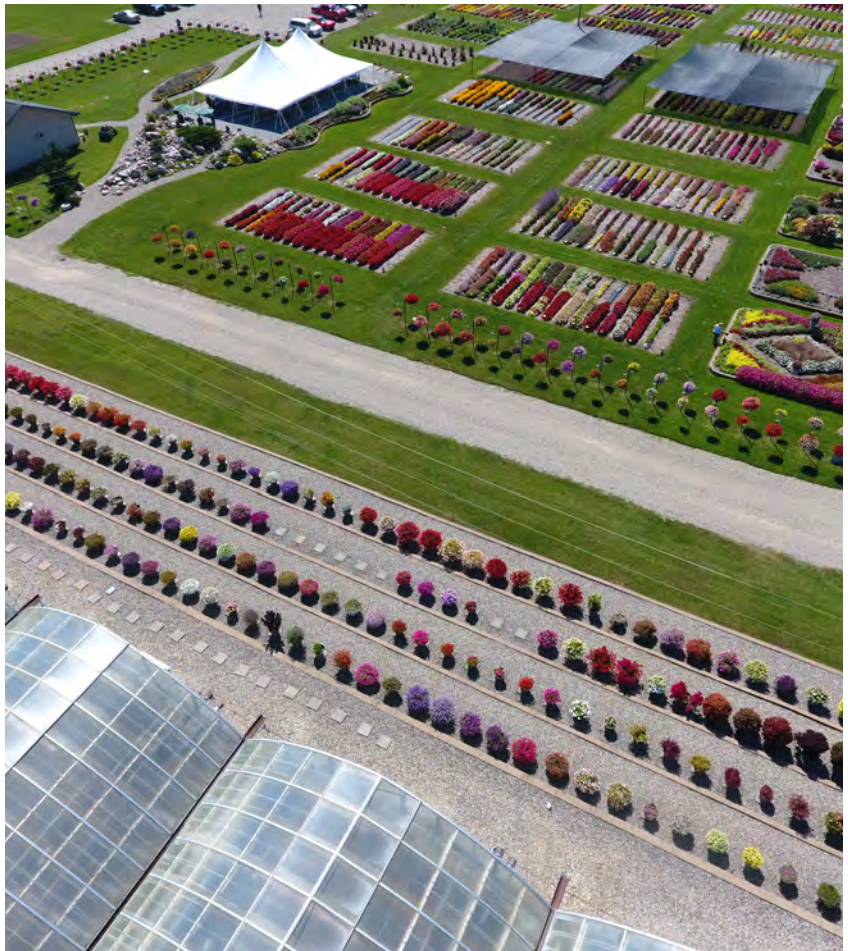

PRIVATE/CLOSED TRIALS

Confidential areas dedicated to trialing new and/or experimental genetics are offered in several areas secluded and isolated from the main Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens' area.

Private / Closed Trials are available for a number of uses: evaluation of unreleased genetics, comparison of commercial vs. noncommercial genetics, application of chemicals or techniques. Raker-Roberta's will work with you to determine the criteria for a valid trial.

Access to Private / Closed Trials is limited to the visitor list you provide. We require all visitors to register upon arrival at the Raker-Roberta's Trial Gardens.

You supply the inputs, applicable care information, and concept explanation. Our team provides propagation, planting, and maintenance throughout the trial season. Also, we offer additional services, such as data and image collection, to suit your requirements. Plant labelling is also based on your criteria.

Areas may be reserved for single or multiple years. Trials may be conducted in rows, hanging baskets, or large containers in full sun or shade.
